**The Player:** Philanthropist and financial adviser Faith Read Xenos, 41. **Latest Play:** Appointed to the board of the Women's Cancer League and Partners, the not-for-profit group that campaigns for the University of Miami/Jackson Memorial Hospital Breast Health Center. **Background:** Partner in Coral Gables-based Singer Xenos Investment Management, a financial advisory firm (retirement, trust funds and estate planning) with \$300 million in assets under management. **Ambition:** Employ her philanthropic fund-raising prowess to keep the center stocked with the latest cancer detection devices. "One diagnostic piece of equipment is half a million dollars.
